

Westcliff drew their Mixed Premier season to a close with a 5-4 win over Eastwood to leave themselves top of the pile. Nicola Waller and Toby Moon secured three perfect rubbers for the home side and were supported by a brace from Adrienne Munro and Lee Scott to end their campaign on 48 points. Kirsty Binstead helped Eastwood to two of their rubbers while Emma Harris and Luke Hill and Laura Whiteman and Matt Allum picked up a rubber each. They move into third and are now unable to challenge for the title.

East Thurrock are now the only side that can catch Westcliff and they kept the pressure up by beating already relegated Westcliff Seconds 9-0. Courtney Downey and Kesh Naidoo, Natalie Smith and Will Sands and Phil Tuffee and Caroline Felton all picked up hat-tricks for the home side. They now move onto 42 points and need six points or more from their final match to secure a first ever Mixed Premier title.

Elsewhere, Hawkwell completed their Masters Premier campaign with a 5-1 triumph over bottom side Fitzwimarc Thirds. Caroline Trace and Alan Morriss both won three rubbers each for the champions as they made it eight wins out of eight. Emma Dixon and Adam Reader picked up the point for Fitz.
