CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1) All competitors must be aged 40 or over on the day of the tournament.
- 2) All competitors must be Members of Clubs affiliated to the SOUTHEND & DISTRICT BADMINTON ASSOCIATION.
- 3) Depending on the number of entries competitors may be divided into more than one group. Each pair will play each other pair in their group. Group matches will either consist of 1, 2 or 3 games to 21 points with NO SETTING.
- Where more than one group is required then the organising committee will explain the playoff/knockout situation on the day of the tournament. This will be impacted by number of entries, available court time and other factors. In general though, we would hope to play a semi-final and final.
- 5) The organising committee reserve the right to refuse or accept any entry. The right is also reserved to adjust the handicap of any pair during the tournament. All decisions by the tournament referee on the day are final.
- 6) Neither the organizer(s) or Chalkwell Badminton Centre can be held responsible for any damage or loss sustained by competitors or spectators attending the tournament.
- 7) The trophies are perpetual. They will be presented at the SDBA annual dinner & dance and must be returned in a clean condition by 1st May the following year.
- 8) Feather shuttlecocks will be used.
